

## Shareholding Merger Form

If each year you receive more than one set of the Company's report and accounts, it means that you have more than one shareholding on the Company's share register. You can merge your various holdings by completing and returning this form to the Company's Registrars at the address given above. Your actual holding of shares will remain unaffected.

**By merging multiple holdings, you will reduce the amount of paper that the Company requires to produce, minimising demand on natural resources.**

Only holdings where there are minor differences in the name or address can be merged, it is not possible to merge holdings in different names or with different designations, or those held through CREST. For example, you cannot use this form to merge joint holdings with individual holdings or vice versa.
