Scope of Work

The Authority has a requirement for scaffolding services to service four of their thermal power stations, located at Great Island, Tarbert, Tawnaghmore and Rhode in the Republic of Ireland.

The intention is to award a non-committed framework agreement with services procured from this as and when required. This will be primarily for access to plant and machinery for routine and non-routine maintenance and plant outages.

Safety of people and the environment is the number one focus at all SSE sites and all service providers will be required to strictly adhere to the safety rules set out at each site while providing a quality service. Thermal power stations by their nature are hazardous environments with regular requirement for entry to confined spaces, such as boilers and cooling water culverts, the service provider shall be able to demonstrate their competence at managing such hazards effectively.

Size / Volume / Length of Project:

The Framework will be a non-committed agreement.

Anticipated Project / Contract Duration:

The Framework will be for an initial period of three years with options to extend for a further five years.

Proposed Strategy:

It is intended to prequalify Applicants on the basis of information provided in response to the PQQ.

The Authority's intention is to arrive at a Short List of Suppliers who achieve a minimum overall score of 60, along with completion of all mandatory questions, and passing all 'PASS/FAIL' questions. Any questions that are scored 'Fail' will result in an automatic failure for the Applicant irrespective of the scores achieved across the other criteria. Short Listed Suppliers will then be invited to tender for the Framework Agreement.

The evaluation criteria and scoring frame are included within the Pre-Qualification Questionnaire.

Proposed Form of Contract

It is the Authority's intention to award an agreement under the NEC3 Term Service Contract (with amendments via Z clauses).

Any resultant Agreement entered into shall be governed under Irish law.

Contract / Framework Agreement

The intention of the Authority is to make an Agreement between the Authority and the successful Supplier. The following are Parties to the Agreement: SSE Generation Ireland Ltd. The Framework Agreement may also be called off by all other SSE Group Companies.
